

# Jared Kushner's Gaza 'Master Plan' is a laboratory for humanity

The master plan—you want to talk about the master plan? Yeah. Well, Jared Kushner has unveiled the master plan for Gaza, a.k.a. the "Master's Plan." He did this at Davos, the gathering of global elites, and this is the brainchild of the so-called Board of Peace, which is headed by Donald Trump with the blessing of the U.N. Security Council. Because, recall that at a recent meeting of the Security Council, Russia and China did not veto a measure that basically makes Trump the leader of Gaza forever. Even after he leaves the White House, he'll still be the head of the so-called Board of Peace. And so Jared Kushner unveiled their so-called master plan for Gaza—as people are still being killed every single day by Israeli bombs, as people are still suffering because they lack food and shelter, all being blocked by Israel, as infants are still freezing to death. Jared Kushner went to Davos and presented to us this dystopian master plan.

This is Jared Kushner—nobody elected him, he's not a member of the U.S. government, and he has no official position. He's simply the son of a Jewish Zionist billionaire whom Trump pardoned, who was, I think, a business partner of Trump, and is now Trump's son-in-law through Ivanka. So he gets to determine the future of the long-suffering population of Gaza through his explicitly titled "master plan."

So we did a master plan. We brought in, I think, Akir Gabai, who's one of the most successful real estate developers and one of the most brilliant people I know. We really need to watch him—he's here to do this not-for-profit, really because of his heart. He wants to do this. And we've developed

ways to redevelop Gaza. Gaza, as President Trump's been saying, has amazing potential. And this is for the people of Gaza. We've divided it into zones. In the beginning, we were toying with the idea of saying, "Let's build a free zone, and then we have a Hamas zone." And then we said, you know what, let's just plan for catastrophic success. We—Hamas—signed a deal to demilitarize. That is what we are going to enforce.

People ask us what our plan B is. We don't have a plan B—we have a plan. We signed an agreement, and we're all committed to making that agreement work. There's a master plan, and we'll be doing it in phases. In the Middle East, they build cities of two or three million people in just a few years, so something like this is very doable if we make it happen. So Rafah will start with a lot of workforce housing. We think this could be done in two or three years. We've already started removing the rubble and doing some of the demolition. And then New Gaza—it could be a place of hope, a destination with a lot of industry, where people can really thrive and have great employment opportunities.

Once this starts going, we think there should be full employment and opportunity for everybody there. We have a lot of data on what can be done, and we think this really gives the Gazan people a chance to live their aspirations. But it all starts with security, and it all starts with governance. Final note—I'll just say, on the Board of Peace—all the work we're doing is basically studying the best practices from all over the world. We're watching who does education best, who does health care delivery best. None of this is secret IP; all of it is IP that the Board of Peace is going to make public. And we want to encourage all countries to follow these best practices.

A lot of the things that President Trump is doing in America—if they're working, we should all be copying them. And if we find what's working in other countries, we should be copying that too. What the Board of Peace will be able to do, if we're successful with Gaza, is really show how to implement peace—something that, when we got this deal done, we didn't find much expertise or know-how on. So as we're creating this system, hopefully we can document these learnings and make them available to anyone else who wants to use them in the future. Demilitarization—this is something we're starting now.

We have a new government in Gaza. This government will be working with Hamas on demilitarization, to really take the principles that were agreed to in the document to the next phase, and hopefully that will be successful. Without that, we can't rebuild. So if Hamas does not demilitarize, that will be what holds back Gaza and the people of Gaza from achieving their aspirations, and that's very important. Over the next 100 days, we're going to stay heads down and focused on making sure this is implemented. We'll continue to focus on humanitarian aid and shelter, but also on creating the conditions to move forward. So thank you. Final point I'll make is that this is really only possible because of the work of so many people and President Trump's great leadership.

But a lot of you have been asking, how can we help? The countries have all been incredibly generous. We'll be holding the first conference in a couple of weeks in Washington, where we'll announce many of the contributions coming from the private sector. There'll be amazing investment opportunities. I know it's a little risky to invest in a place like this, but we need you to have faith, invest in the people, and try to be part of it. And finally, I'll just say to people in the media and on social media—this deal only happened because we worked with Israel, Turkey, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, and Egypt.

I mean, everyone worked together. We worked with the UAE. We all worked together to make this happen. I see a lot of people trying to escalate, you know, criticizing—criticizing Israel, or Israelis criticizing Turkey or Qatar. Just calm down for 30 days. I think the war is over. Let's do our best to work together. Our goal here is peace between Israel and the Palestinian people. Everyone wants to live peacefully. Everyone wants to live with dignity. Let's put our efforts toward promoting those who are doing the work to build this up, like Ali and his committee.

Let's focus on the positive stories, and let's just... calm down, turn a new chapter. If we believe that peace is possible, then peace really can be possible. We're going to continue to work every day, and we need all of your help to do it. Again, I just really want to thank President Trump for his leadership in making this happen. This would not have been possible without your commitment. Everyone thought it was impossible to end this war, but you never gave up, you never stopped. Every time there was a setback, you told us to try harder, you gave us different ideas. We've made several impossible things happen in Gaza already, and there's no reason we shouldn't be able to make even more impossible things happen. So, really.

So, yeah. A Jewish Zionist real estate guy gets to redesign Gaza into a biometric concentration camp, with the support or consent of those who want to buy into Trump's pay-for-play "Board for Peace," which requires a \$1 billion buy-in. It's modeled after the UN Security Council logo, but with gold wings. God. So Trump is aiming to replace the UN Security Council and create a one-world Trumpian government. And Gaza—so Gaza becomes the basis for this one-world biometric, radical Zionist, one-percent, Trump-incorporated government that countries must pay into in order to enrich Trump and his cronies for a seat at the table. And Turkey and Qatar have agreed. And Russia and China did not veto this plan at the Security Council. And now Putin is buying into it.

And Putin's only condition, apparently, is that he wants frozen Russian assets to pay for his initiation fee. That's his only concern. I mean, how somebody's not boycotting this thing is beyond me. Spain has boycotted it, to their credit. But how anyone can sign on to this—there are no Palestinians. In fact, the Board of Peace doesn't even mention Palestinians in its charter. And there are no

Palestinians on the so-called Board of Peace. It's mostly Zionists, including Benjamin Netanyahu, who has been invited by Trump. And I believe he accepted—yep, yep—and then, um, yeah, their plan for Gaza itself... well, maybe we'll get to that. But it truly is every single dystopian fantasy distilled into one. I mean, this really is it right here. And the fact that they want to do it on what is essentially a mass grave—build new concentration camps inside a concentration camp they've destroyed—you really couldn't write it if you were trying to imagine something so hellish.

In 1948, quote-unquote, Israel was created. Palestinians were subjected to the Nakba. That was when the whole infrastructure of the post–World War II international order was established, including the UN, the model of the Security Council, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and the Geneva Conventions being developed into this international framework. And yet the UN voted to establish Israel—one of the most shameful crimes in modern history. And now it's all come full circle following the Gaza Holocaust. From one Holocaust to another, the UN is being outmoded by the Trumpian one-world government, known in the most Orwellian terms possible as a "Board of Peace," with the consent of key regional players.

And let's go back to Gaza, where we'll see the master plan in detail. Again, I just want to emphasize this: this is a map of Gaza, but it's coming to a neighborhood near you if we allow it to happen. This is a model for humanity by our AI warlord masters. Here's what the map looks like. You can see yellow is where the so-called "un-people," the refugee un-people, will live. The brown areas are for industrial complexes and data centers. Then there's one road along the side for highways and local transportation. Parks, agriculture, and sports facilities are shown in green.

There's a port that looks pretty good, and an airport. Everything's based in the south, though. Up north, that brown zone—those are the refugee camps that Israel wiped off the map. Jabalia, Beit Hanun, Gaza City—it's all reduced to a tiny little space. There's a park in the middle of Gaza City to shrink the residential areas. And here's a pretty good analysis of what this map means from someone named Hamza Attar. Pink is where the rich live; yellow is for the workforce—the slaves who will work in the data centers and sweatshops.

Then a little more, if you can.

Yeah, whitewashing and normalizing Israeli occupation. So look at these white areas here — those are the ones bordering Israel. Israel gets this massive buffer zone. There's no border with Egypt, so the Philadelphia Corridor is completely controlled by Israel. They're shifting boundaries from Gaza City to Khan Yunis and Rafah in the south. Gaza City's population is now the highest, but that'll be

reversed because Gaza City is the base of the middle class in Gaza, as well as the governing facilities. The industrial hubs mean relying on the Israeli supply chain — electricity can be cut off whenever Israel wants. Rafah and Khan Yunis are being engineered as attractive cities to move Palestinians away from Gaza City toward the south.

It will also move Palestinians toward Egypt and push them out, ultimately. The new port was moved to Rafah to be adjacent to the Israeli-occupied area. It's an Israeli-controlled port. Then there's a marina for the rich—an island for wealthy investors or rulers to live away from the population, that's in section 10. So there it is. I mean, it's basically a gigantic, biometrically controlled smart city. And right now, as Aaron pointed out, Gaza is being bombed. Several journalists were murdered two days ago while covering an Egyptian humanitarian foundation ceremony. People are being killed for trying to return to their homes across the so-called yellow line, which is in the white areas on that map, because that's where Israel is now demolishing homes.

And Jared Kushner refers to that in his speech. He says, "We're clearing out the rubble. We're clearing out the rubble." Israel is blowing up homes across the yellow line to create the basis for this giant biometric concentration camp known as Gaza. That's where they're going to build the new Rafah, which appears in the maps from the master plan — the PowerPoint presentation of the master plan — and the new Khan Yunis. Then they're going to move in on the areas controlled by the resistance in Gaza. They say they need to demilitarize and de-radicalize in order to push the population into these camps — basically de facto slave camps, reservations. They're already there, but now they're imposing this map on top of them.

The Palestinians have never mattered. Their voices don't matter. There are no Palestinians on the Board of Peace. They don't exist as humanity. They didn't exist in 1948 when the UN voted, and they don't exist today. And this is, again, a model coming to you in the techno-feudalist future — and the only thing standing between it and us is the Palestinian resistance. The Palestinian resistance, represented by murdered voices like Abu Obeidah — yeah, I said it — they were the true freedom fighters of humanity, standing against the Tony Blairs, the Larry Ellisons, the Jared Kushners, and the Gulf slimebags who want to profit from this. That's the reality. And yes, Tony Blair is on the Board of Peace. What can we say about the figures on the Board of Peace?

The fact that Trump picked Tony Blair — it's almost as if he wants to go out of his way to insult the people of the Middle East, to just flaunt in their faces that he's the colonial overlord, to the point where he's going to install someone who took part in the invasion of Iraq, which has now led to so many millions of deaths. I mean, the arrogance, the hubris here — Trump putting in Tony Blair — because why else would you put in Tony Blair? I mean, yes, he's connected to all the Gulf monarchies, yeah, sure, but he's just showing such contempt for the people at every opportunity he can.

And the fact that Jared — again, that you pointed this out — Jared Kushner, on top of being a Jewish Zionist American, is being, you know, handed the keys to Gaza, doesn't even have a government position. So who is this guy, and why is he there? He's there because he's Israel-first. And that's what the message is. If you want to have a future, if you want to be able to survive in your own land — if you're Palestinian — you have to put Israel's needs first. And that's what the master's plan does here in Gaza.

It's a multi-tiered global payola system as well. To get on the board of "peace," you pay Trump money — a billion dollars — and then below Trump is Jared Kushner, the fixer, who has this company taking in investments. It's an investment firm getting money from the Emirati sovereign investment fund, for example, and from all these Gulf billionaires. He wants to profit from Gaza — and who else could profit from Gaza? There you see all these data centers planned for Gaza: Oracle, the AI warlords. And so they have to pay Jared Kushner to get into Gaza. Once there, they can profit from the genocide of Palestinians by "rebuilding" this seafront property — quote unquote, rebuilding it. Larry Ellison's directly involved here. Yes, the owner of TikTok — whose son, Israel-firster David Ellison, a close contact of the Israeli government — took over Paramount and handed the keys to CBS to Bari Weiss.

The Ellison family are involved through Tony Blair because they're paying for the Tony Blair Institute. I think they're one of the largest donors — Larry Ellison and Oracle are. And that's why Tony Blair is out there advancing digital ID and all these surveillance-capitalist techno solutions. Watch this — this is a chilling clip that I think took place at a conference in the United Arab Emirates. It's actually called the World Government Summit. Like, if I were some John Birch guy from the 1950s, everything we're talking about would've made me blow my brains out. Watch — this is so... Can we stop saying "dystopian" and "Orwellian"? I need a thesaurus. This is reptilian shapeshifter Tony Blair, modeled after Nikolai Carpathia, the Antichrist from Tim LaHaye's *\*Left Behind\** series.

Unify all of their data so it can be consumed and used by the AI model. You have to take all of your healthcare data — your diagnostic data, your electronic health records, your genomic data. The NHS in the UK has— did you hear what he just said? Genomic data. An incredible amount of population data, but it's fragmented. It's not easily accessible by these AI models. We have to take all of this data we have in our country and move it into a single, unified data platform. So we provide context — when we want to ask a question, we've already given that AI model all the data it needs to understand our country. That's the big step, the missing link. We need to unify all of the national data, put it into a database where it's easily consumable by the AI model, and then ask whatever question you like.

Tell us about—so even genomic data, like the stuff 23andMe uses and potentially more. Actually, if you go to prison or even jail for a day, the marshals try to get your DNA. So DNA, all of your data, all centralized in one place for the AI warlords to access. That's the Palantir model. Palantir has been proposed as a potential participant in Gaza after they took part in the genocide, providing targeting assistance to the Israeli genocide machine. And they're at the World Government Summit. It's all just being rammed in our faces right now—what they want. And Tony Blair, that's how he got the seat, I think, on the Board of Peace. That's the future. The one thing standing against it, that can complicate it, is the resistance in Gaza that's being asked to disarm and move into biometric concentration camps, to provide their data, their genomic data, their DNA data—to Larry Ellison's One World AI data center.

What's amazing to me is that Palestinians in Gaza are arguably the most surveilled population in the world already. But under this plan, they'd find new ways to intrude into people's lives and control everything they do — like, to eat, to be able to live in one of these new population centers, you'd have to give up your data. Everyone's eyes would be scanned. It's—again, I'm sorry, it's a trope at this point—dystopian. But they want to somehow increase the surveillance of one of the most surveilled populations in the world.
