

# Lebanese rally against negotiations with Israel

The Grayzone's Wyatt Reed reports from the Dahiya district of Beirut, Lebanon, where hundreds of supporters of Hezbollah rallied against the unconstitutional negotiations between the Lebanese government and Israel aimed at compelling Resistance factions to disarm. ## #Wyatt Reed

Here in Beirut's Yahya district, at the Martyrs of the Islamic Resistance Square, behind me, there's a huge gathering of supporters of the resistance. People are coming together to express their support not just for Hezbollah and the local resistance movements here in Lebanon, but for what's called the Axis of Resistance movement — the movement against Western imperialism, against American hegemony in the region. This comes as Donald Trump is threatening to attack Iran and attack them very hard.

The people here are expressing their support for the local resistance, for Iran and for Palestine, for the people of Gaza, who they say cannot stand up for themselves in just the same way that the people here in Dahiye are being subjected to external aggression. The government of Lebanon doesn't speak for everyone. It speaks for a small, as they see it, U.S. and Saudi-imposed group of foreign collaborators. Sellouts, they say. These people are looking for an alternative future, one which is not dictated by the United States, by the West, one which they say will allow them to develop on their own terms. How did she feel the other day after Israel bombed Dahiye and Iran responded on behalf of the people of Lebanon?

Donald Trump, just a few hours ago, threatened to attack Iran again — attack them very hard. How does she feel when she hears that?

The so-called government of Lebanon has been involved in ongoing negotiations, they say, with the Israelis and the United States. What is her opinion about these so-called negotiations?

Tell us, what do you think about this president of yours?

### **#Speaker 1**

Thank you.

### **#Wyatt Reed**

Any message for the people of the United States? Obviously, our tax money goes to pay for the bombs that are blowing up people in the South every day. What would you say to people in the United States?

### **#Speaker 2**

I am Jawad Al-Shamy from Yemen. I came to prove to myself and to my men here in Lebanon the honor and dignity. We are victorious over the devils. America and Israel are the sons of Abyssinia. We bless the Lebanese and the Palestinians. God distinguishes them in this feature — to fight the Israelis, the evil devils.

### **#Wyatt Reed**

I want to ask about the complete ban that Ansar Allah has just imposed on Israeli ships going through the Red Sea. Can you tell us more about why this decision was taken and what it means for the region?

### **#Speaker 2**

The real happiness and success is not in America or in France or in Europe. The real happiness is to be shoulder to shoulder on the front lines with the heroes. We hope to give you a great surprise. We say to the Iranians and Yemenis, you are supposed to give Israel 15 days — either stop the madman or play in his garden. I mean, don't wipe him out, because he only understands the language of power.

Last question. Tell us, if you could give a message to the people of the United States whose tax money is being spent on all this aggression against the region, against your country, against this country, against Iran — what would you say to the people?

## **#Speaker 2**

The world is at a standstill. Help the oppressed in Lebanon, in Palestine. We love you all. We don't have a problem with anyone. We have a problem with the biggest devil, with Trump and his administration. And the administration behind him is the Masonic administration. We saw them in the Abyssinian Peninsula, how they were enjoying the children, the children's blood.
